Methodology

- There was an expansive outreach conducted from March 16 – April 2 to secure member input.
- This survey was sent electronically to 359 email addresses, which were comprised of chapter members as of August 2020 and March 2021 (in case of any lapses). Reminder emails were sent to those who did not open the initial appeal as well as subsequent original mailings. A last call email was sent as well.
- An appeal was included in the March Chaptergram, on social media, and on /Nteract.
- Twenty-seven people responded for a 7.5% response rate. The average time to complete the survey was 3 minutes.

Highlights

- Members are interested in a variety of events with the top three being:
 - Emerging Issues Panel or Speaker (17)
 - Educational workshops for license CEs (15)
 - Leadership/Professional/Career Development (15)
- The preferred format is webinars. (18)
- Approximately half are interested in social events (14)
- Although any weekday works, most preferred afternoons, mid-week
- There are several topical areas of interest. Those are listed on Question 4. No speakers were identified.

Highlights Continued

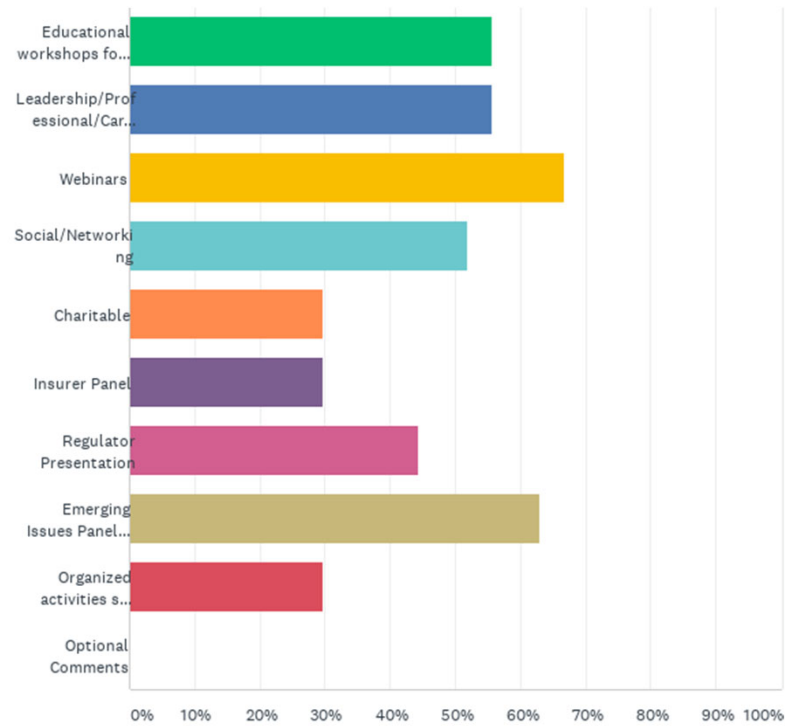
- The majority (62.96%) read the Chaptergram, though a few stated they never saw it. There were several comments, which can be inferred as suggestions. Two people recommended including a Data Puzzler with a \$25 gift card to the winner.
- Nine respondents indicated interest in volunteering, but only one provided contact information.
- The majority (66.67%) did not attend I-Day, primarily due to timing/conflicts. A few (4) said they did not hear about I-Day.
- The majority of respondents (61.54%) prefer I-Day 2021 to be hybrid.

Highlights Continued

- Twenty respondents provided their information for the \$50 gift card drawing, with one recusal. The winners were randomly selected:
 - Barbara Burns, CPCU
 - Ajay Marathe, CPCU

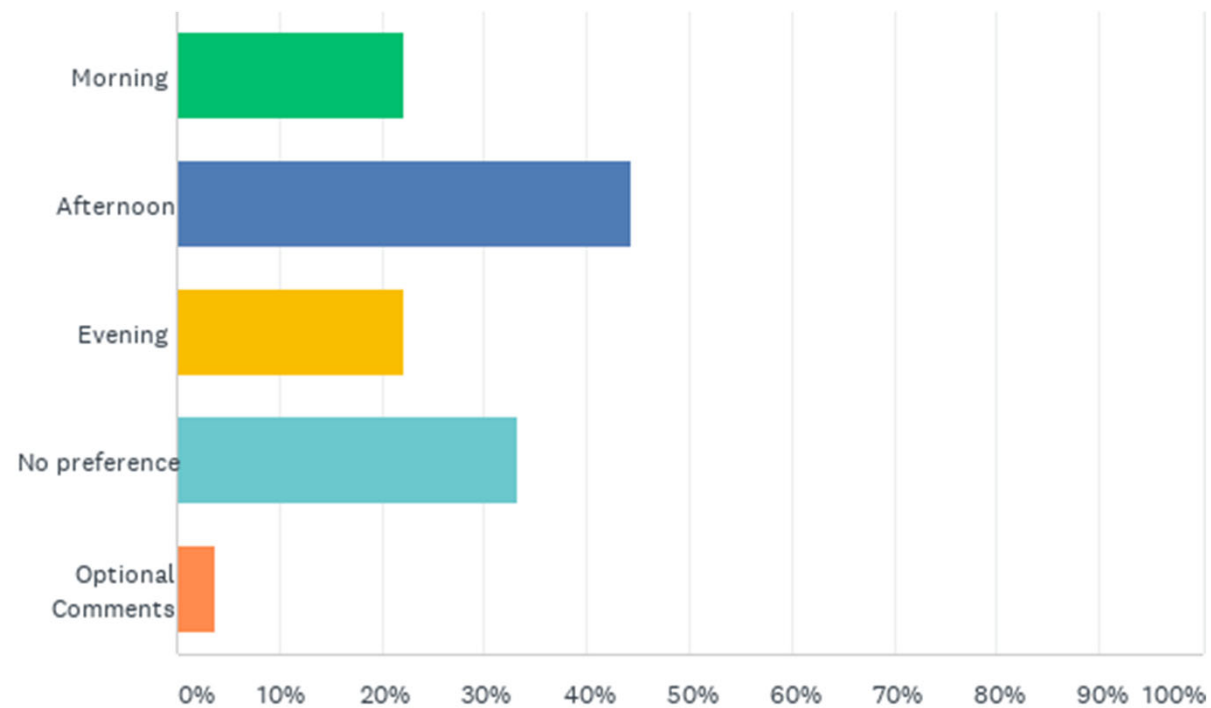

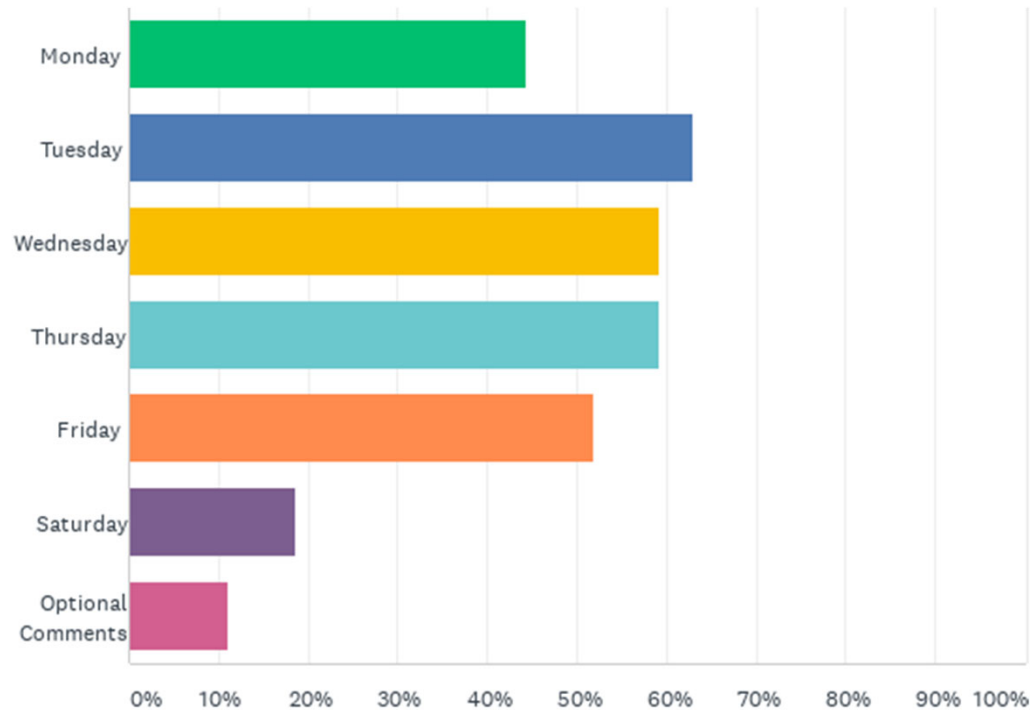

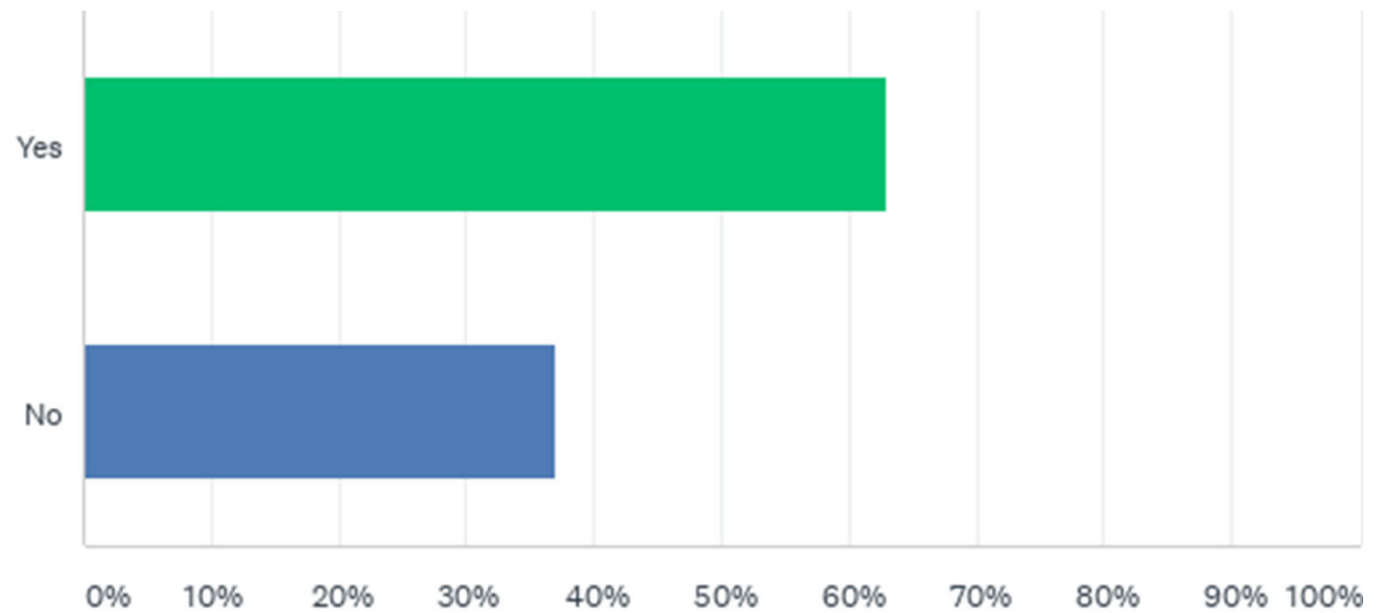

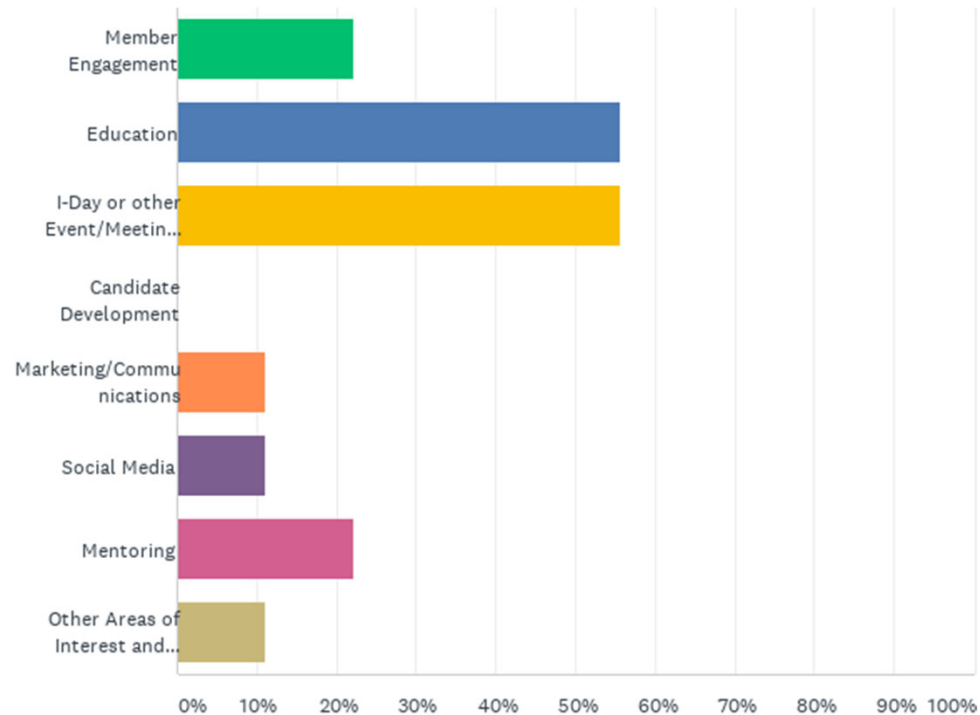

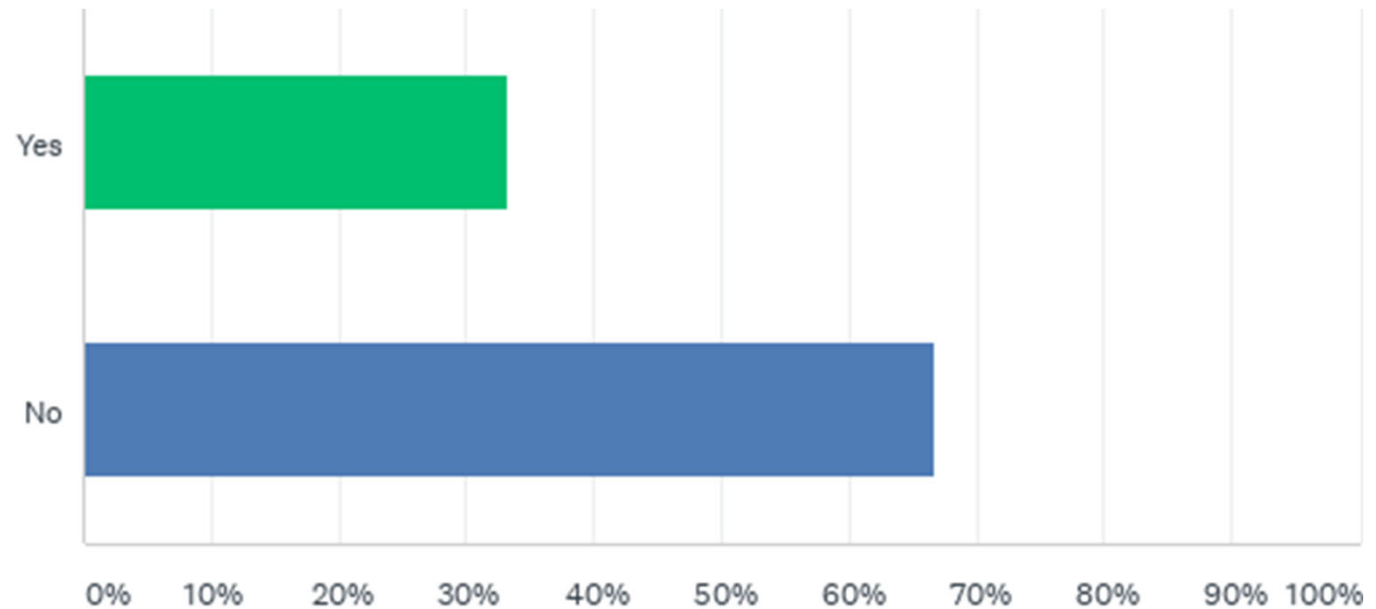

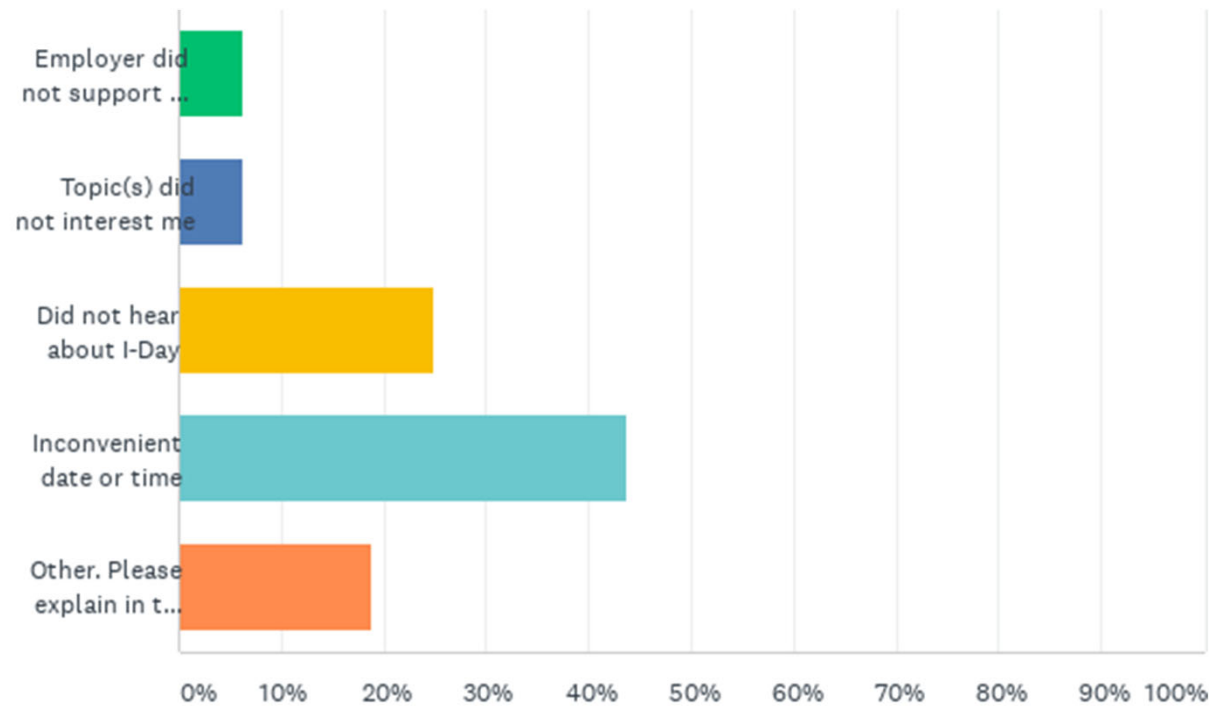

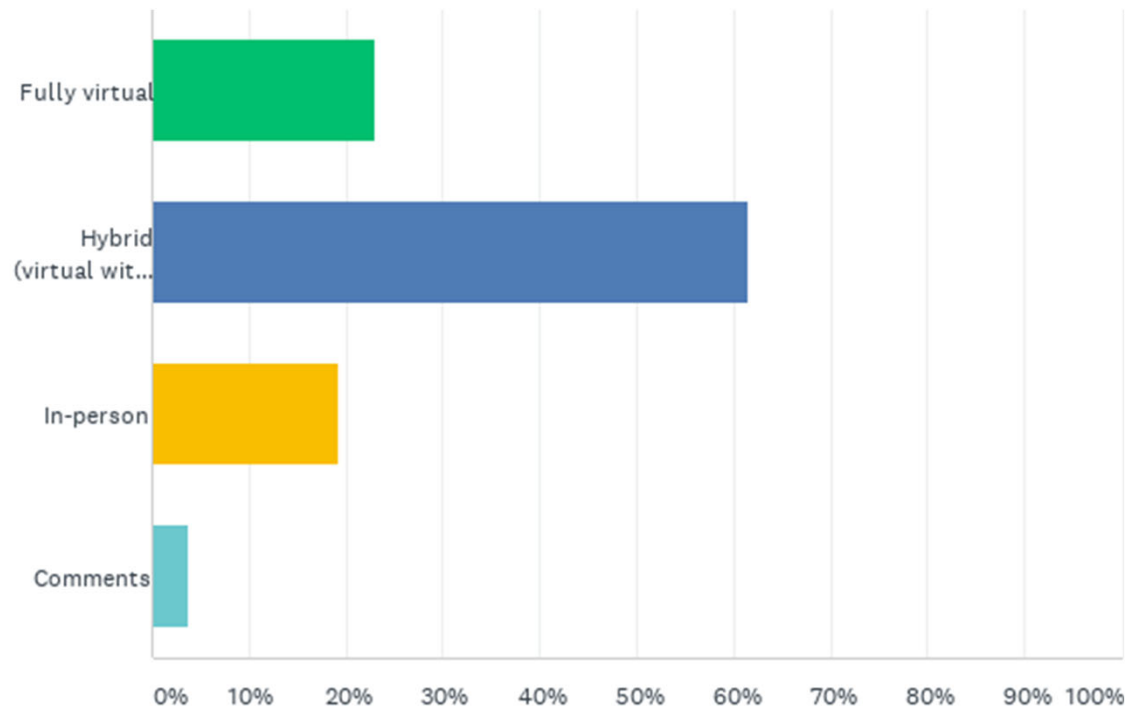
